Average monthly rent for UCLouvain accommodation (a room) is €295.



Which courses?

At ESL, you will find Master level courses in Economics. A full track in English is possible.

At the Faculty ESPO, you will find Bachelor level courses in Economics, Social and Political Sciences and Communication and Master level courses in Social and **Political Sciences and Communication.**

At the Bachelor level, there is a limited number of courses taught in English.

Note: at UCLouvain, Economics and Management are two different degrees taught in two different schools.

We ask that you take at least 50% of your courses at the ESL and/or the ESPO Faculty.

Workload

- A normal workload represents 30 ECTS per semester.
 - I course of 5 ECTS represents on average 30 contact hours.
 - We expect you to have a workload comparable to the one you would be required to have at your home institution.

French courses

French courses are organized by the Institut des Langues Vivantes (ILV) from beginner to advanced level.

- If the language course is part of your learning agreement, you are allowed to attend courses without extra charge (max. 3 French courses).
- If it is not part of your learning agreement, you can attend courses for all the languages EXCEPT English, Dutch and Spanish. You will be considered a "free student" (standard fees will apply).



A passion for research

The 3,600 UCLouvain researchers represent an impressive pool of knowledge and skills. Their quality can be measured by the number of European Research Council (ERC) grants, the European grants of excellence, that they win each year: in 2023, they numbered 56. UCLouvain scientists also benefit from the LouvainTRANSFER "turnkey" service for promoting their research results.

Innovative and open teaching

At UCLouvain, teachers are encouraged to place innovation at the core of their teaching. To this end, they can count on the support of the Louvain Learning Lab (LLL), a leader in its field. In addition, since sharing knowledge with as many people as possible is one of its key missions, the university has placed open science and open education at the centre of an ambitious digital transformation project.






A university on eight campuses
