A verification is required on these terms. The applicant is obligated to have achieved a minimum average score of 11 points during all four semesters of the higher level English course (“Leistungskurs). A general level English course (“Grundkurs”) is required to have a minimum average score of 13 points during all semesters.</p> <p>If the language qualification is not proofed through the report cards of the “Abitur”, the issuing institution needs to additionally confirm that the proof</p>

of language qualification are on a comparable qualification level as the “Abitur”.

Applicants, whose first language is English, can also reach the criteria by submitting official documents stating that the applicant has learnt the given language as their first language in their young childhood and without formal classes and additionally has lived a minimum of eight out of their first twelve years in a country, in which the given language is the national language.

The proof of:

- A high school diploma allowing one to study in a university.,
- Another equivalent English university entrance qualification or
- A job qualification of a minimum of three years of studies at a college or university, with the English speaking credits being a total of 180 ECTS-Credits or similar,

in an English speaking country (national language to be English) replaces the general proof of language qualification and the required level is reached.
