Crediting a module as an Equivalent subject

- The content of the modules must be largely equivalent. Credits may differ from those at HU - in case of recognition, the performance will be credited exclusively with the LP according to PO/SO of the HU. Any excess ECTS credit points expire.
- The content of the preliminary examination must be carried out by the responsible subject representative (confirmation on Learning Agreement) - preferably before the start of the semester abroad.
- The technical examination can also take place after the stay abroad - in this case, there is no entitlement to recognition as equivalent performance.

If the examination applied for has already been not passed/passed, a recognition of the recognition of the examination performance is excluded.
