- Advanced Macroeconomic Analysis I (PhD-Level) (6) (WiSe)

Field B: Economics (18 CP):

- Advanced Labor Economics (6) (SoSe)
- Advanced Monetary Economics (6) (SoSe)
- Competition Policy (6) (SoSe)

Field C: Economics and Methodology (30 CP):

Field D: Business and Economics (18 LP):

If more than 60 credits are completed in areas A-C, area D is reduced accordingly.

Interdisciplinary Electives (ÜWB) (10 CP)

10 CP from:

- Interdisciplinary electives from other faculties of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin
- Language courses at the Language Centre **,
- Career Centre courses (excluding introductory courses in economics and law)
- Interdisciplinary and specialised courses from other universities
- Interdisciplinary and specialised courses from abroad
- Economics-related internship (at least 6 weeks full-time, or at least 12 weeks half-time 10 credits)***

* If applicable, grades awarded for courses from the ÜWP are not taken into account in the calculation of the final grade.

** Language courses in the respective mother tongue or official language of the home country as well as German courses for foreigners below B2 level CEFR are not recognized. German courses for foreigners from A1 level will be recognized if the student started their studies after winter semester 2024/25. Subject-related English courses from C1 and non-subject-related English courses from C2 level are recognized.

*** The internship must be completed within the master's programme and is not a mandatory part of the ÜWP. It is therefore not possible to issue a certificate for a compulsory internship.

Important note: Examinations that have already been successfully proven in the course of the bachelor's degree program may no longer be taken in the Master's program. Double crediting is excluded.
